Position Summary

DragonFly Landing is seeking a Licensed Therapist with a minimum of 5 years of experience to provide trauma-informed, in-office and community-based therapeutic services to youth, individuals, and families.

This role is hourly to start, with eligibility to transition to a salary position following a 90-day review, at the discretion of the Executive Director.

The ideal candidate is comfortable working in dynamic environments, is aligned with Whole Person care, and is willing to engage in supervised visitation work as part of their clinical responsibilities.

Weekly clinical supervision is provided as part of this role.
Expected direct service hours are a minimum of 28 hours per week.
