

Job Title: Youth Services Provider

We're looking for a compassionate and consistent Youth Services Provider to support youth and families in building stability, connection, and long-term wellbeing.

Our work is grounded in the belief that every area of life—emotions, school, friendships, family, physical health, and mental health—is interconnected. We also operate through a trauma-informed care approach, prioritizing safety, trust, consistency and empowerment in all interactions with youth.

This is a hands-on, relationship-based position that may include evenings and weekends depending on programming needs. You'll be part of a supportive team focused on helping youth thrive through consistent meaningful engagement.

The ideal candidate brings strong emotional intelligence, patience and the ability to build genuine consistent relationships with young people. They are grounded under pressure, dependable, open to learning, and motivated by **helping youth grow through connection, not control.**

What you'll do:

- Build strong, positive relationships with youth through mentorship and daily support
- Coach youth in emotional regulation, communication, and life skills
- Assist with after-school weekend, and community-based activities that build confidence and connection

- Provides crisis support and de-escalation when needed (training provided)
- Collaborate with support staff and team members to ensure consistent care
- Complete timely documentation and session notes after services
- Provide transportation to youth as needed (per program guidelines)
- Participate in ongoing training, supervision and team debriefings

What we're looking for:

- Experience with youth or families preferred
- Strong communication and relationship building skills
- Ability to stay calm, supportive and grounded in high-stress situations
- Willingness to learn trauma-informed care practices
- Valid driver's license and reliable transportation
- A degree in human services social work psychology or related field is preferred but not required
